January 5, 1930 - February 28, 2009

Tremonton, UT – Deloria Anita Price Williams, wife, mother, grandma, sister and friend, 79, passed away Saturday, February 28, 2009 at the Intermountain Medical Center in Murray, due to complications of cancer, surrounded by her loving family. Anita was born January 5, 1930 in Samaria, ID to Deloria Ann Peterson and Evan Morse Price. She was reared and educated in Samaria and graduated from Malad High School.

She married her high school sweetheart, John Jack Leon Williams, March 12, 1951 in Samaria, ID. The marriage was later solemnized in the Logan, Utah LDS Temple December 10, 1965. John L. passed away January 31, 1990.
